

Demonstrations Policy

POLICY 1.0

Responsible Executive: Vice President of University Operations, Events and Safety Responsible Office: University Operations, Events, and Safety

1. POLICY STATEMENT

Demonstrations on University property may be organized only by members of the University community and must be peaceful and orderly. Demonstrations must adhere to time, place, and manner restrictions designed to (a) protect the health and safety of participants and the campus community, (b) avoid disruption of the regular and essential operations of the University, and (c) maintain an atmosphere conducive to scholarly and educational pursuits.

In addition, all demonstrations must be registered in advance and in writing with the Vice President for University Operations, Events, and Safety or designee. That office will review the registration and advise whether the demonstration is approved, and if so whether it is subject to any time, place, and manner restrictions. Organizers of a demonstration must acknowledge agreement to any time, place, and manner modifications before proceeding.

2. SCOPE

This policy applies to all University of Notre Dame students, faculty and staff.

3. POLICY ENFORCEMENT

Enforcement

Demonstrations that have not been registered, or which do not adhere to applicable time, place, and manner restrictions, may be stopped, and participants may face consequences up to and including arrest. In addition, those who violate or are suspected of violating this policy may be referred to the Office of Community Standards, the Office of the Provost, or the Office of Human Resources, as appropriate, for further action.
